



\$1,000 - \$5,000 Scholarship for High School Seniors Entering College or University in a Public Works Related Major

The Ventura County Chapter of the American Public Works Association (APWA) is pleased to announce the availability of scholarships for high school students entering college or university in an engineering/public works related major from any high school located within the APWA Ventura Chapter membership region. The region includes cities of Agoura Hills, Camarillo, Calabasas, Fillmore, Moorpark, Ojai, Oxnard, Port Hueneme, Santa Paula, Simi Valley, Thousand Oaks, Ventura, Westlake Village, and County unincorporated areas.

Applicants must be a 12th grade student and/or graduating high school in the spring or summer of 2024, and who will be attending college or university in the fall of 2024 and will be pursuing studies in a public works related field of study. Examples of public works related fields of study are as follows:

- Civil or Structural Engineering
- Mechanical or Electrical Engineering
- Traffic/Transportation Engineering
- Geology or Geotechnical Engineering
- Geographic Information Systems
- Sanitary Engineering
- Environmental Sciences
- Public Administration
- Construction Management
- Architectural Sciences
- Land Surveying
- Urban Planning
- Public Management
- Geography
- Utility Operator

Please note that not all engineering majors are related to public works (i.e. biomedical engineering, aerospace engineering, and marine engineering). The selection of the scholarships will be based on the academic achievements of the student and his/her expressed interest to pursue a career in a public works related field.

To be eligible for consideration for a scholarship, the applicant must complete and submit the application form posted on <https://ventura.apwa.org/resources/scholarships/> and other required documents listed in page 2 of the application.
