- **Contract Completion Date.** Include the original contract completion date and note any approved time extensions.
- **Construction Management.** Describe the construction schedule, management strategies, and control techniques used. Highlight any innovative materials, sustainable practices, or funding approaches.
- **Safety Performance.** Provide data on safety performance, including number of lost-time injuries per 1,000 man-hours worked and details of the overall safety program implemented during the construction phase.
- **Environmental Considerations.** Outline measures taken to protect the environment, such as efforts related to endangered species or sensitive habitats.
- **Community Relations.** Summarize outreach efforts to protect public safety, minimize inconvenience, and foster positive community engagement.
- **Challenges and Accomplishments.** Describe any unusual accomplishments under adverse conditions (e.g., adverse weather, soil, other site conditions over which there is no control).
- **Additional Considerations.** Share any noteworthy innovations in technology, design, or project management.

Projects may only be nominated by the managing public agency or an APWA chapter.

If a project spans or involves multiple APWA jurisdictions, it may be co-nominated. In such cases, each participating chapter will receive credit toward submitting a PACE Award nomination, and all chapters involved must be clearly identified on the nomination form prior to the judging process.
